

2009 Summer Fun Golf Camps

Learn to play golf this summer! Let the Summer Fun Golf Camps show you the simple secrets to hitting the golf ball consistently with distance each time you swing. Learn how to chip it close, and putt with confidence! Develop the skills you need to enjoy this great game of golf for a lifetime.



Choose your week and days: *Students may enroll for more than one week.

Week 1: June 15 - June 18

Week 2: June 22 - June 25

Week 3: June 29 – July 2

(All camp weeks run Monday-Thursday with Friday as a rainout make-up day.)

Daily Times: (1.75 hour daily sessions)

- 8:00 AM – 9:45 AM
- 10:15 AM – 12:00 PM

Cost: \$105 per week. Students may sign up for multiple weeks. All campers receive a photo bag tag, t-shirt, and instructional materials.

Camp Format: All sessions run Monday through Thursday, with Friday as a rainout make-up day. Students within each session are grouped by age, ability level, and friends for maximum comfort. Class sizes are kept low to ensure lots of personal attention!

All Summer Fun Golf Camp lessons are lead by a select staff of experienced coaches, golf professionals and adult instructors in small group settings using real golf balls at a real golf course. These groups rotate through stations during the week that teach the fundamentals of grip, stance, posture, full swing, putting, chipping and pitching. In addition, demonstrations of etiquette, strategy, and efficiency are also presented to each group. More advanced topics include sand play and course strategy. A individual assessment program will help identify a student's strengths, as well as provide incentives to progress to the next level.

- Level 2 – (Yellow) Advanced Beginner
- Level 3 – (Red) Intermediate
- Level 4 – (Blue) Advanced Intermediate

Located on Cliff Road, Eagan. ½ mile east of Pilot Knob Rd. Facilities include a full driving range, putting green, and an 18-hole executive golf course.



Class Levels: Please use the following guidelines to register for the proper class level. Every effort will be made to group students by age, ability level, and friends for maximum comfort within the given levels.
NOTE: All campers must be 7 years of age or older by June 9, 2008.

Ability Guidelines for this Camp:

GREEN- Open to all golfers who are new to the program and have never played golf before.

YELLOW- Open to all golfers who have completed the Green program successfully or to golfers who can consistently (3 of 5 times) hit a 7-iron 25 yards in the air. 9-hole target score=72 from the short tees.

RED- Open to all golfers who have completed the Yellow program successfully or to new campers who can consistently (3 of 5 times) hit a 7-iron 50 yards in the air. 9-hole target score=63 from the short tees.

BLUE- Open to all golfers who have completed the Red program successfully or to new campers who can consistently (3 of 5 times) hit a 7-iron 75 yards in the air. 9-hole target score=54 from the short tees.
